Title: Village partners with Master Builders & Hands-Across-Canberra to deliver Charity House

I am very pleased to inform you that we are partnering with the Master Builders (ACT) and charity foundation Hands-Across-Canberra to build a Charity House, which will be auctioned with the proceeds going to vulnerable Canberrans.

Village's partnership in the Charity House initiative was announced by Chief Minister, Andrew Barr, on Friday, 26 October at a Hands-Across-Canberra lunch at the Gandell Hall.

The Charity House concept was developed by MBA ACT back in 2013 and is delivered with charity partner, Hands-Across-Canberra, the ACT government and a selected property development company. The Charity House concept has completed three projects so far and have raised close to \$3,000,000 for local Canberra charities.

The Village Charity House will be one of the homes in our Weston Creek precinct development and is likely to be ready for auction in 2020. The proceeds from the sale (minus cost of labour and materials) will go to a range of charities, selected by Hands-Across-Canberra.

The Charity House project is a great example of what can be done for the community when government, the industry body and business come together.
